Children at Ashgate Specialist Support Primary School have been benefitting from the 2 new Acheeva beds thanks to MedEquip4Kids. It has made it so that children with complex needs like Jordan Joseph can continue to attend school comfortably for as long as possible. One of the members of staff at the school said, "The children can lie down when they need to and be positioned comfortably throughout the day. The best thing about the Acheeva bed is it is not like a hospital bed but is child-friendly and accessible and therefore enables the students to be in class alongside their friends. You have made such a difference." A brand new Safespace Cot has been delivered to Zoe's Place Baby Hospice in Liverpool. This cot has allowed 18 children with both life-limiting and life-threatening conditions such as epilepsy, cerebral palsy and spinal muscular atrophy to stay overnight at the hospice. Michelle Wright at Zoe's Place said "If we didn't have this Safespace cot, we would have to refuse respite to some children, which would impact on family's wellbeing and the children's health and life experience. 3D Distraction Equipment at Stepping Hill



Brand new 3D distraction equipment is in place at Stepping Hill providing distraction and relief from pain for children undergoing painful procedures. They can now interact with a new range of 3D games and videos to help keep their minds relaxed and occupied when undergoing procedures such as blood sampling and cannulation.

Refurbished waiting area for Greenbank clinic

Greenbank clinic now has a variety of new and different equipment to cater to sensary needs and make the space more welcoming for the children coming into the clinic. This has benefitted 750 people already including children and their families and will continue to do so for years to come. One of the clinic nurses said "We now have a child friendly environment that we can welcome our children and families to. This makes appointments a lot less daunting, and a lot more fun! Children are able to engage in sensory activities during appointments with parents which helps them stay more regulated. We now enjoy inviting families into our clinic rooms and are so grateful for the support".
